

**CAMPBELL, George Constantine [UNTD YORK '43] (1925 - 2008) Age: 83**



Mr. Campbell, age 83, died on Friday, December 19, 2008, at St. Joseph Mercy Oakland Hospital, in Pontiac, Michigan. He was born on March 28, 1925, in Windsor, Ontario, Canada, to Constantine and Katherine Campbell. He had been a resident of Waterford, Michigan, and former longtime resident of Bloomfield Hills, Michigan.

Education: Mr. Campbell earned a Bachelor of Engineering Degree from the University of Toronto.

Occupation: He was the founder and owner of Campbell Metal Parts. He began the company in Troy, Michigan in 1956.

Mr. Campbell was an active member of St. Nicholas Greek Orthodox Church, and was a Past President of the Hellenic Society.

Military: He proudly served in the Canadian Navy during WW II.
