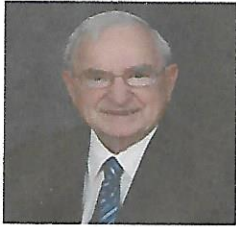


HILTZ, John Samuel [UNTD SCOTIAN(Acadia) 1948 U-34200] (1929 - 2016) Age: 87
