He graduated Assumption College with a BA '51 and UofT with a DDS in '56.

I did meet him at the 2006 Old Oars Mess Dinner in Ottawa, but back then I wouldn't have been asking these questions. Having no date-of-birth detail, I'm assuming that he joined HUNTER in '48 but it might have been earlier in the pre-Cadet days.
