Gene had WWII RCNVR Service on the lower deck and as an 18-year-old was present off of Normandy on D-Day.

He entered U Saskatchewan in 1946 on a DVA education grant and had 3 UNTD summers; '47, '48. '49.

He was promoted to INST LT RCN, sen. 1 Jan '50 (later back-dated to 1 Jan '48), O-76663, attached to SHEARWATER.

In 1955 he was at CORNWALLIS.

He was promoted to INST LCDR, sen. 1 Jan '56, attached to SHEARWATER and later served in BONAVENTURE.

In 1960 he was attached to STADACONA and in 1965 was at NADEN.

He was a long-serving member of both the CNAG and NOAC Ottawa Branches and was President of the latter from 1998 - 2000.
