U.N.T.D. TRAINING MEMORANDUM No. 7/59

UNTD SUMMER TRAINING - 1959 - INSTRUCTIONS and INFORMATION.

Reference: COND:4921-186(P8) dated 27 Feb. 1959.
CANDIV 025/59.

The following plan and instructions for UNTD Summer Training are forwarded for your action and information.

3. UNTD Cadets will be allocated to the Coasts on the following basis:
- (a) All FIRST YEAR Cadets to the EAST Coast.
 - (b) All SECOND YEAR SUPPLY Cadets to HMCS "Hochelaga".
 - (c) SECOND YEAR CONSTRUCTOR Cadets to the EAST Coast.
 - (d) The remainder of SECOND YEAR Cadets to the WEST Coast
 - (e) THIRD YEAR CONSTRUCTOR Cadets to HMCS "Bytown" for NCC.
 - (f) With the exception of eight Cadets selected for duties on the West Coast, the remainder of THIRD YEAR Cadets to the EAST Coast.

In order to complete as many courses as possible, Second Year Cadets with either ABCD or a Divisional Course outstanding - or both of these courses - are to commence Second Year courses rather than remain idle waiting for ABCD or Divisional Courses, if these two courses are not immediately available.

4. Second Year Cadets (S) shall be employed in the Division until the beginning of the Second Year (S) Technical Course scheduled to begin Monday, 1 June, in HMCS "Hochelaga".
6. In order that Cadets from classical colleges complete as much of the fourteen weeks Required Training as possible, they are to be advised that no Required Training will be approved where any delay occurs between the closing date of the college and the arrival of the Cadet on either coast.
7. In order to simplify formation of classes, as many Cadets as possible are to arrive at the Coasts at the start of the Training Season. In previous years, it has been difficult to fill the ships of the first cruise and keep the classes ashore up to their numbers, thus placing a heavy load on later classes and cruises, with the result that some Cadets have been unable to complete all required courses during the training season.
- 8(b) Cadets are to be advised that they may only change training dates when necessary, and not for their own convenience. In previous years not all amendments to NR5D's were necessary.
9. To assure the efficient handling of Records and the quick allocation of Cadets on their arrival at the coasts, Documents are to be forwarded to arrive at the coasts at least three weeks in advance of the Cadets.
10. Cadets are to be Medically examined in accordance with BRCN 3009(56) Article 3.03(1) and BRCN 2074 Article 1.01(Table), Sect. 1(j) and are to be given a chit signed by the P.M.O. stating that they have been found medically fit to undergo RT and SD. This chit is to be presented by the Cadets at the Coast during the "YN ROUTINE".
